



Important Points to Always Remember!

1. Some of you may have interactive parts of the show. Evidence of Evil is not a “Say Boo!” type of haunted attraction. In fact, we hate that...a lot. We aim to have an engaging element to the show. Come out of your shell and have fun! We will work with you on how to scare if needed.
2. Please do not wander throughout the show prior to opening without permission. You may be needed for something and we cannot take the time to go looking for you.
3. Please take note of where emergency exits and fire extinguishers are in your area.
4. You are responsible for throwing away your own garbage and will be expected to do so.
5. The show will be opened nightly by the one or both of the owners. Once you see him/them, guests will be walking into the show. Stay in your spot and be ready! Guests will be entering the attraction on a consistent basis until the show closes for the evening. You MUST remain in your spot until the end of the night and please do not congregate. There is nothing worse to break the suspense of a haunted house than the sound of shuffling feet as actors rush back to their spots. Trust us, after that, they already know where you are; your scare is blown.
6. NEVER put yourself in danger by acting as “Crowd Control.” If you notice anything, please let the nearest staff member know. Please be sure to get a good description of the person in question.
7. If a child becomes separated from their parents, we will call and Amber Alert. ONLY THE OWNERS CAN CALL AN AMBER ALERT. If a parent tells you they have lost their child, immediately find a staff member and they will take it from there. If an Amber Alert is called, the show stops IMMEDIATELY. Actors and staff are expected to keep all guests in place and stop all movement throughout the show. You may come out of character during an Amber Alert. The show will resume once the child is found; it usually takes only a few minutes.
8. If there is a fire, DO NOT PANIC. The show audio will stop completely, and an evacuation message will play. Please escort yourself and any guests around you out of the show and as far away as you can get. Do not put yourself in harm’s way to assist others.
9. Please use the bathroom before the show opens!
10. If you have any suggestions for the show, please do not be shy! We strongly encourage open lines of communication to keep the show growing stronger each night.
11. Make friends! Your cast-mates will be your new family for the month.
